UNIPD - University of Padua

Objectives:

Discuss the system requirements arising from the elaborate use cases and from a developed IR use case model/space with the developers of the DIRECT system (UNIPD).

Description:

SICS is responsible for the Work package 2 “Stakeholders Involvement and Technology Transfer”. Involving the stakeholders in the development of the PROMISE system and especially in future utilization of the research results achieved in the context of PROMISE is an important task of the PROMISE project. Formulating realistic evaluation tasks based on valid and interesting use cases is the primary means to increase the stakeholders’ involvement in the project.

It is vital that the use cases will be taken into account when the PROMISE system is designed, so that the requirements they pose to evaluation, metrics, visualization etc will be taken into account. The WP2 has set a goal of formalizing the first use cases based on the three Promise use case domains before the end of the summer 2011. After this it would be appropriate for the responsible people at SICS to discuss the system requirements arising from the use cases with the system developers at University of Padua to see if the system or the use cases need to be adjusted somehow.
