1 Opportunity

UvA is gaining and gathering knowledge of evaluation methodologies which can be used on operational systems as part of their task 4.4. The ZHAW led task 4.5 aims to adapt methodologies from evaluation campaigns to make them applicable to existing corporate systems. We would like to exploit the obvious connection between the aforementioned tasks by having a research exchange between UvA and ZHAW.

2 Expected Impact

UvA and ZHAW share their hands-on knowledge of evaluation methodologies, benefitting their respective institutions, tasks and the entire project. A significant boost of productivity in the specific tasks as well as in related future work can be expected. ZHAW will also gain first insights for their WP2 task 2.5 best practices report.

As an additional result of the exchange, we intend to make the outcomes available to all project partners in the shape of a short report, outlining the major findings.

3 Logistics

We propose that Stefan Rietberger (ZHAW) visits Amsterdam (UvA) at their site for the duration of a work week (5 days). A workplace is to be prepared for the visitor (one person), providing access to their own remote and the host's local IT infrastructure. All costs incurred to the host and associated with the exchange are to be compensated by the consortium research exchange budget. Travelling and accommodation are handled as usual. The exchange is foreseen to take place in June 2011.
